VISA APPLICATION

PROCEDURE

- 1. Deposit and registration of the visa application forms at the Embassy reception;
- 2. Payment of the visa fee at the Paymaster Office and to get a receipt;
- 3. The minimum delay for the examination of the visa application is five (5) days for ordinary visas and two (2) days for diplomatic visas;
- 4. The application forms are dropped every day (working days) from **09HOO** to **13HOO** and collections are done every day (working days) from **15HOO** to **17HOO**:
- 5. The passports collection at the Embassy Reception by the applicants after signature in the appropriate register.

N.B

- -The access to the consular office is prohibited to the visa applicants
- The fact that the required documents are submitted does not automatically lead to the issuing of a visa.
- The visa fees are not refundable and any visas refusal will not be justified
- -Any application submitted that does not follow the above requirements, will be purely and simply rejected.

- 2. A letter from working place in South Africa
- 3. The itinerary of ticket
- 4. Copy of vaccination card/yellow-fever certificate
- 5. 2 passport size photos

DIPLOMATIC VISA

- 1. Note verbal
- 2. 2 passport photographs

REFUGEE CASE

- All required documents +Refugee status document three (03) months validity

1. Single entry: R850.00

2. Multiple entries: R1 250.00
